On our walk this morning, it was cold for spring and blowing reasonably hard. The sky was entirely full of dull gray stratus clouds that billowed into interesting shapes, like feathers spread across the sky. The temperatures were 29.6°F and 9.8°C, the humidity was 45% and the air pressure was 30.01 inHg. The wind was coming from the West North West at 8.1 mph. It was, in short, a pretty dull day. We did, however, see a few birds...
