Today it was sunny and beautiful outside. The clouds, which were cumulus, filled only 3 oktas of the sky. They were puffy and were formed into different shapes by the wind. Speaking of the wind, it felt cold at some points on the walk because it was blowing hard. The highest recorded wind speed I got was 7.5 mph from the West South West. The temperatures are 64°F and 17.8°C, the humidity is 24% and the air pressure is 29.86 inHg. Considering that it was raining and snowing (yes, I know, snow in April!) yesterday, this is great weather.

On our walk we saw a Red-tailed Hawk being attacked by a belligerent crow, saw a tom turkey crossing the field, saw two White-throated Nuthatches building a nest in a woodpecker hole, and heard a squeaky bird that might have been a finch.
