2-10-09

On our walk today it was warm and cloudy. The clouds formed a gray wall of Altostratus Undulatus which covered about 8 oktas of the sky. They were not forming and dissipating as quickly as the clouds yesterday, but did twist and turn a little bit. The wind was coming from the NW at 5 mph down here, but must have been blowing a gale high up in the sky, because the clouds were really moving along up there. The air pressure was 30.18 inHg, the humidity was 51% and the temperatures were 46.4°F and 8.2°C. It is a nice day today.

We saw a turkey vulture being mobbed by some crows, a sapsucker banging its beak on a tree, and some sparrows fluttering around. A mockingbird preened itself in a bush, and flocks of starlings did noisy cartwheels in the distance. We thought we heard frogs, but it was just someone banging away on something.
