It's the second day of the second month of 2009, and it's bright and sunny and hot outside. Seriously hot (for this time of year)! The temperatures are 56.1°F and 13.4°C, and we were sweating in our thick coats and ski pants. The wind is coming from the NEE at 3.5 mph, although it must be moving faster than that up in the sky, because we could see clouds racing along at an alarming rate. Speaking of clouds, the sky was about 6 oktas full of a layer of stratus (that was rapidly becoming stratocumulus) and a higher layer of cirrus. The air pressure is 29.85 inHg and the humidity is 35%.

This morning we saw some sparrows and a mockingbird, which was very cute. The ground was slippery and hard to get a grip on. It was warm and slushy.
