1-21-08

The sky this morning was about 4 to 5 oktas full of drifting cirrus and cirrostratus clouds, that were transparent to translucent (it was hard to tell some times). The highest recorded wind speed was 0.5 mph from the NE, but it was definitely higher than that at times during the walk. The air pressure is 29.95 inHg, the humidity is 43% and the temperatures are 23°F and -4.7°C. The snow is powdery and drifts underfoot. We spotted some enormous icicles; one hanging from the airstream was so long it had touched the ground and grown into a puddle of ice there!

The only animals we saw today were some crows that cawed noisily at us.
