When we started on our walk this morning, the clouds were Cirrostratus and were high up in the sky. They covered the entire sky, from horizon to horizon, and were slightly translucent. There is probably a warm front on the way, dad says, which will bring precipitation, probably snow as it is cold. The wind was coming at 2.5 mph from the NW, the air pressure was 30.45 inHg, the humidity was 49% and the temperatures were 23.9°F and -4.5°C.

This morning we saw some little sparrows, some crows, and heard a Cardinal. Something that was very cool was seeing a Pileated Woodpecker up close. He allowed us to get very close to him as he pecked holes in a tree, and dad got a whole bunch picture of him!
