1-29-08

The sky this morning was clear and blue, except for some cirrus clouds high up in the sky that gradually multiplied. In the beginning of the walk they filled about one okta, by the end, about two oktas. The air pressure is 29.98 inHg, the humidity is 43% and the temperatures are 33.4°F and 0.8°C. It is above zero degrees, as you can see, but you can't really tell that outside. The wind is coming from the NE at 3.5 mph, and it whistled loudly in my ears on the walk.

The ground on our driveway is just a sheet of ice this morning. I didn't even bother walking across it, I just walked around, going behind the airstream. It was easier to walk in the woods, though, as the ice was more crunchy. We heard quite a lot of birds, and saw a mockingbird and some starlings.
