This morning, it was chilly, but not as wet as it has been. The humidity is only 71% today, which is a big drop from 98%! The temperatures are 40.3°F and 4.6°C, which is also warmer than it has been. The wind is blowing from the North West at 2 mph, although it obviously blowing harder than that up high, as the smoke from the chimney is blowing out almost horizontally. The air pressure is 30.36 inHg, and the sky is 8 oktas full of billowing Altostratus clouds. It is quite dark outside.

We saw two birds of prey sparring above the trees. One folded his wings up and dived at the other, going very fast, but the other managed to dodge. They moved too fast and were too far away for us to see what they were. We also heard some crows, some Mourning Doves and what might have been a woodpecker. We saw a cardinal.
