3-13-09

When we started out for our walk this morning, the sky was 1 okta full of wispy cirrostratus clouds, which were slowly billowing South-Eastward. You can probably tell from this that the wind was blowing from the North-West. It was blowing at a 5.5 mph high, and was quite a chilly breeze. The temperatures were 40.8°F and 4.6°C, although I am sure it was colder than that earlier. The air pressure is 30.51 inHg, and the humidity is 37%.

We didn't see that many birds this morning, just a few crows, what might have been a raven, and a Blue Jay. We did, however, see a tree budding and its flower beginning to bloom.
