

Jack's Nature Journal
3-17-09

We started our walk this morning by observing the cloud cover and the types of clouds. There were some very interesting clouds, and I spotted altostratus, cirrostratus and altocumulus clouds, which filled about 3 oktas of the sky. The wind was coming from the NW at a recorded high of 1.5 mph. The sun was shining brightly, which made it feel extremely warm (except when it was windy!), but it was warm already. The temperatures are 59.9°F and 15.4°C, the humidity is 36% and the air pressure is 30.30 inHg. It is a lovely day.

This morning we saw a mockingbird, a cardinal, heard some crows, saw some happy little juncos flying around, heard and saw some angry squirrels, and heard a very strange bird call.
