On our walk this morning, we were buffeted about by higher winds than we have been experiencing recently. I recorded 8.5 mph from the North West, but I'm sure it blew higher than that on our walk. The sky is 4 oktas full of rapidly moving and changing Stratocumulus clouds. The temperatures are 57°F and 14.3°C, the humidity is 53% and the air pressure is 30.18 inHg. It is bright and sunny and beautiful, although a bit windy, as I mentioned earlier.

We saw a cardinal flitting about in the bushes and some sparrows. We couldn't get any close ups because I forgot the binoculars.
