

Jack's Nature Journal  
3-24-09

There were, once again, no clouds at all in the sky this morning. The whole sky was a big blob of various shades of blue. The sun shone down brightly, as there was nothing to cover it up, and it was quite a beautiful day. The temperatures are 49.9°F and 9.7°C, although it was much, much colder than that earlier (it was down just above 20°F early this morning!). The wind is coming from the WNW at a recorded high of 7.5 mph. The humidity is 27% and the air pressure is 30.45 inHg.

This morning we really didn't see that much bird life, just some robins hopping around in the Wicki's field, gobbling up worms and grubs, a lot of noisy starlings and a couple of crows flying around. We also saw some trees budding, and the Forsythia just about to bud.
