It was cold this morning. Well, not cold for winter, but as winter changes into spring, our perception of what is cold changes. So I suppose it just **felt** cold this morning. The temperatures were 43°F and 6.1°C, and it felt even chillier because of the pressing humidity. The humidity was 79% and the air pressure was 30.06 inHg. It started raining lightly halfway through the walk, and I was glad I thought ahead and brought a rain coat.. The wind was coming from the South at a recorded high of 5.4 mph. The billowing stratus clouds covered eight oktas of the sky.

This morning, we saw starlings and cowbirds sitting in a tree, making a lot of noise, a ragged turkey vulture and some robins in a field. We heard a Red-bellied Woodpecker, and saw a kettle of turkey vultures. We also saw some bear scat in the woods. He (or she) had definitely been eating from the deer feeder, as we saw corn in it.
