On our walk this morning, it was really gusting. The wind was blowing along so fast that, even though it was actually pretty warm, it felt cold. The recorded wind speed I got this morning was 8.7 mph from the West North West, but that was after we had gotten back and it had calmed down a bit. It was going way, way faster than that on the walk. The air pressure was 29.74 inHg, which is unusually low. I wonder if the weather is brewing something up. The temperatures are 50.1°F and 10.1°C and the humidity is 39%.

This morning, we saw some little Coltsfoot flowers sprouting up along the side of the road, a turkey vulture soaring high over our heads, propelled by the wind, a whole bunch of deer in a field, and a couple of crows. We also heard a Wood Frog.
