The clouds this morning covered 2 oktas of the sky. They were probably cirrostratus, and were arranged in thin strips that went across the sky like rivers of cloud. They moved like rivers, too, as I saw one moving across the sky quickly in a high wind. There aren't any high winds down here, though. I only recorded 0.5 mph and I couldn't get a wind direction because there was no wind at all when I tried! The temperatures are 48.9°F and 9.4°C, the humidity is 27% and the air pressure is 30.42 inHg. It is bright and sunny.

This morning we saw some House Finches that fluttered about in the trees, a turkey vulture, some crows that cawed at us loudly, and a male cardinal. Well, I couldn't actually see the cardinal, but mom assured me that it was there. Funny. Anyway, we also saw some dogs that barked at us loudly and menacingly.
