This morning, the sky was 8 oktas full (entirely full) of swirling Altostratus clouds. However, they didn't entirely block the sun, being slightly translucent, which meant that it was quite bright. It was hard to see if I didn't have my sunglasses on. The wind was coming from the NW at 1 mph, which is at least better than yesterday. The air pressure is 30.06 inHg, the humidity is 47% and the temperatures are 48.7F and 9.3C. The snow is melting fast now.

This morning we saw a turkey vulture, some crows that cawed loudly, a mockingbird sitting in a bush and three cute little sparrows squabbling.
