5-13-09

This morning the sky was five oktas full of cumulus clouds that were constantly billowing about in the wind. There was not that much wind today, only 3.6 mph from the South South West, but there must have been more up high. The air pressure is 30.42 inHg, the humidity is 24% and the temperatures are 72°F and 22.2°C. It was warm and sunny, and it was nice to not feel a chill breeze as we walked.

We saw and heard a **lot** of Red-winged Blackbirds, screeching and flapping their red-striped wings at us, a Baltimore Oriole flying overhead, some sparrows and crows, heard a woodpecker, saw a bluebird and our very first Black Swallowtail Butterfly this spring. We also saw two Damselflies mating.
